New for 2019, ACOG is introducing a one-day, standalone OB coding workshop: **DEMYSTIFYING OBSTETRIC CODING AND BILLING: EFFECTIVELY REPORTING THE ROUTINE AND THE HIGH RISK.** This course is dedicated to clarifying the principles of obstetrics billing and coding, as well as equipping the provider and their staff to appropriately report services to a variety of payers and circumstances. This highly interactive session will provide attendees the opportunity to develop critical thinking skills as they learn through detailed case studies. Course agenda will include; demonstrating how to differentiate between “global” and separately reportable services; identification of the differences billing/coding of “routine” and “high-risk” obstetrics services; reporting ultrasound and other diagnostic services; coding for unique obstetrical circumstances, and detailed discussions of developing issues in the field of obstetric care as they influence billing/coding of these services.
